

## **Central Cairo**

### **Egyptian Museum**

Open daily: 8:30 AM - 5:00 PM built in 1902, in a beautiful, neoclassical style, the Egyptian Museum stands at the north end of Tahrir Square. It is home to artifacts and relics dating from the Old Kingdom of Pharaonic times up to the period of the Roman Empire's involvement in Egypt. Sights to see include the Tutankhamen Galleries, containing most of the contents of the young Pharaoh's tomb, including his world-famous golden face-mask and the equally impressive two inner-sarcophagi.

The Royal Mummies Room is a great attraction. Eleven of Egypt's ancient rulers lie in individual glass cases. The museum is literally a treasure-trove of Pharaonic artifacts, including papyrus, jewelry, tools and statues. We recommend purchasing a guide to the museum from the museum bookshop or getting a guided tour.

Admission fee is applicable.

### **Abdeen Palace**

Open daily: 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM Easily reached from Mohammed Naguib metro station, the Abdeen Palace was built over eleven years and finished in 1874. It was designed by French architect Rousseau and contains more than 500 rooms. Abdeen Palace was the official residence of the kings of Egypt until King Farouk abdicated in 1952. The museum inside contains mostly weaponry, and some porcelain, silver and jewelry of this age. Cameras are not allowed.

Admission fee is applicable.

### **Cairo Tower**

Open daily: 9:00 AM - midnight Located at the center of the Island of El Gezira in Zamalek and capturing fantastic views of the city, the Cairo Tower is worth a visit on clear days or at night when Cairo lights up. A revolving restaurant provides some meals.

### **Cairo Opera House**

Built on beautifully landscaped gardens, the Opera House is the best place to see ballet, opera and musical performances in the capital. The grounds have sculptures, fountains and beautiful gardens. Shows can be enjoyed at the main hall, the small hall or the open-air summer theatre. The Manager Gallery usually puts on art exhibitions, including the Cairo Biennale.

### **Mahmoud Khalil Museum**

Open daily: 9:30 AM - 6:00 PM In the former home of Mahmoud Khalil, a famous politician of the 1940s, this museum has the finest collection of European art in the Middle East. Many originals can be found, by great names such as Van Gogh, Lautrec, Gauguin and Monet, to name but a few. The quality of works and the range of exhibits is really a pleasant surprise. It is definitely worth a look for all art lovers.

Admission fee is applicable.

### **Pyramids and Giza**

The Pyramids and Giza Plateau being one of the Seven Wonders of the World, it's no surprise that people come from all over the world just to see the Great Pyramids. The three large pyramids belonged to three Pharaohs of the Old Kingdom: Cheops, Chephren and Mycerinus. The largest pyramid on the site (and in Egypt) belonged to Cheops and standing almost 140m high. You also have to see the magnificent Sphinx and adjoining temple.

It is also worth seeing the Solar Boat Museum, at the foot of the Pyramid of Cheops.

### **Sound and Light Show**

This show uses the Sphinx as narrator as he and the pyramids are lit up in an elaborate sound and light show. It's a good spectacle and a way to learn about Egypt's great history. There are three shows a night, at 6:30 PM, 7:30 PM and 8:30 PM, one hour earlier in winter. The shows are in Arabic, English, French, German, Spanish, Italian, Russian and Japanese. The program changes all

the time, so check with our Concierge, available 24-hours. Please dial 10 Admission fee is applicable.

## Day trips

### Khan El Khalili

Cairo's world-famous souq (shopping area), Khan El Khalili is a market place where shops sell alabaster pyramids, belly dance outfits, ethnic jewelry, shisha pipes, brass ornaments, spices as well as perfume essences. Everything you could want in terms of souvenirs can be found here, along with bargaining fun. You can rest in El Fishawi, one of Cairo's oldest cafes.

It has been operating for the last 200 years boasting beautiful wall mirrors, which date back to the 17th century.

### Memphis

Memphis was once the capital of Egypt during the Old Kingdom. The city was founded around 3100BC by King Menes when he managed to

unite Lower and Upper Egypt. There's a museum that holds some artifacts including a large statue of Ramses II. There is also a garden with statues of a large Sphinx. the sarcophagus of Amenhotep and several of Ramses II.

Admission fee is applicable

### Sakkara

Sakkara was the necropolis of Egypt during the Old Kingdom; it is a massive site of funerary complexes, pyramids and temples.

The most obvious symbol of Sakkara is ZOSER'S Step Pyramid. This pyramid built for King Zoser in around 2700BC, is the world's oldest pyramid. Other attractions include the great Mortuary Complex and other pyramids and Mastabas.

Admission fee is applicable.

## **Islamic Cairo**

### **Al-Azhar Mosque and University**

The world's oldest university founded in 970 AD, and one of Cairo's first mosques. Repeatedly enlarged over its long history, Al Azhar is a mixture of architectural styles, and is one of Islamic Cairo's most beautiful buildings, especially at night when the minarets lit up.

### **Hussein Mosque and Midan El Hussein**

The Hussein Mosque is one of Islam's holiest sites in Egypt, due to the fact that Hussein's head (the Prophet's grandson) is buried here.

It is as amazing to view this lovely mosque from the outside as it is from the inside. Going inside, women should cover up. The Hussein Mosque marks the northern side of Midan Hussein, one of the most important public squares of Mediaeval Cairo. This square is a good place to catch your breath after too much time on the crowded streets of Khan El Khalili. But be advised that during Eids, Moulids (especially that of Al

Hussein) and Ramadan nights it is packed with visitors and booming with loud music.

### **Museum of Islamic Art**

Open daily: 8:00 AM - 4:00 PM Fridays from 11:30 AM - 1:30 PM this museum contains the Middle East's (if not the world's) finest collection of Islamic art works. It includes woodwork, ceramics and Islamic weaponry as well as ornate Kor'anic manuscripts, It is located on Port Saïid St, opposite Midan Bab Al Khalq. Admission fee is applicable.

### **The Citadel**

Open daily: 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM Built in 1176 by Salah El Din to protect the city from the crusaders, the citadel occupies one of Cairo's main vantage points opposite the Muqattam mountain. Its lit-up minarets can be seen all over the city's Eastern skyline. Post- Salah El Din, the Mamluks added palaces and mosques in their typical Mamluk style.

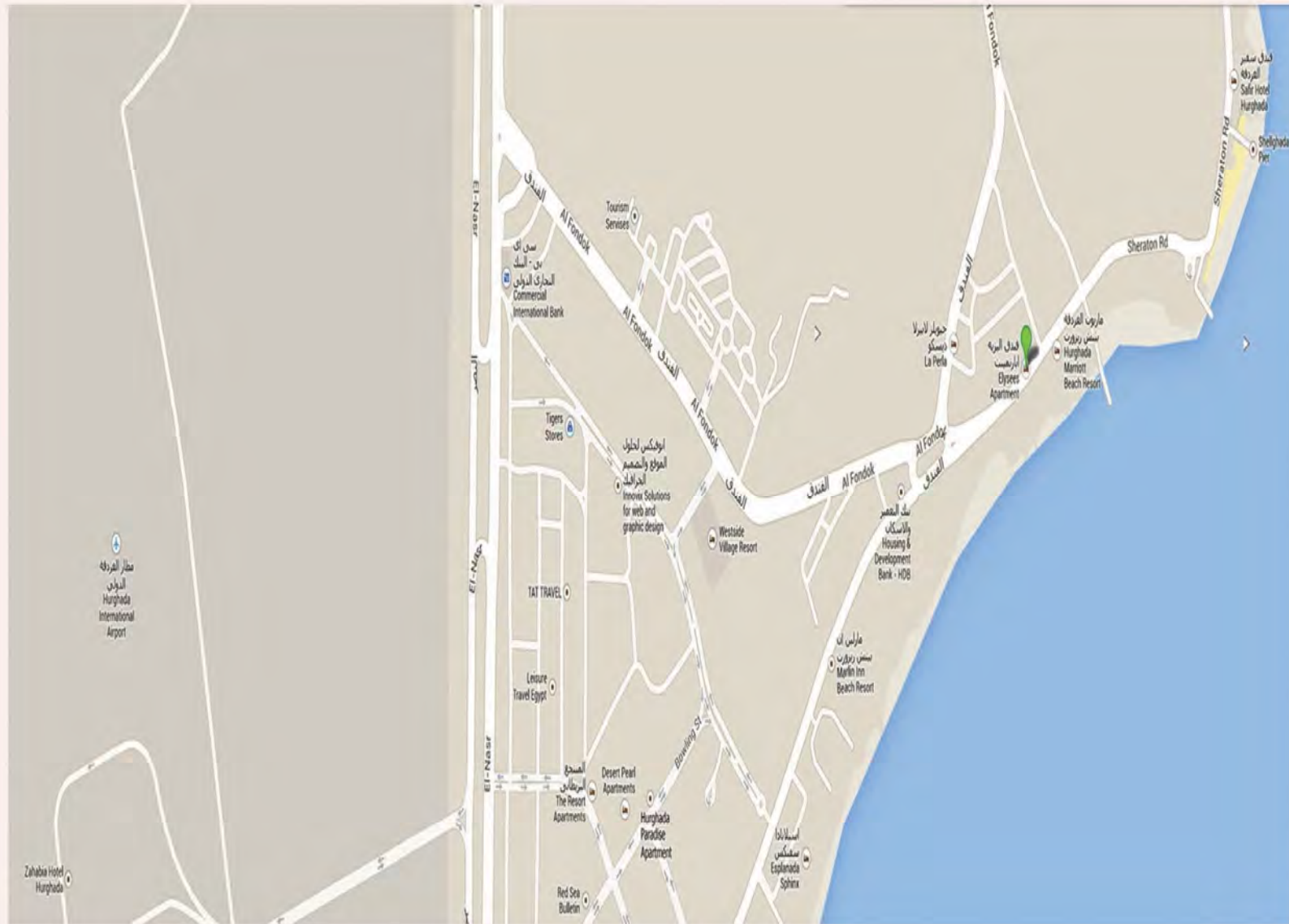
These sadly fell into disrepair under the Ottomans, who added a new gate and enlarged the citadel further. The Mosque of Al Nasir Mohammed is the only surviving Mamluk structure in the citadel. Mohammed Ali later added the huge mosque, with its distinctive Turkish style, that still dominates the site. This mosque took 18 years to build (finished in 1848) and Ali's tomb lies inside. The Mosque of Soliman Pasha, finished in 1528, is of the Ottoman era, with exquisite recently restored painted woodwork. The National Military Museum, the Carriage Museum, the Seized Antiquities Museum, and the Police Museum are other sites to see. The citadel today hosts some great concerts and dance shows nowadays organized by the Cairo Opera House. Admission fee is applicable.

### **Mosque and Madrassa of Sultan Hassan**

Open: 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM (6:00 PM in summer)

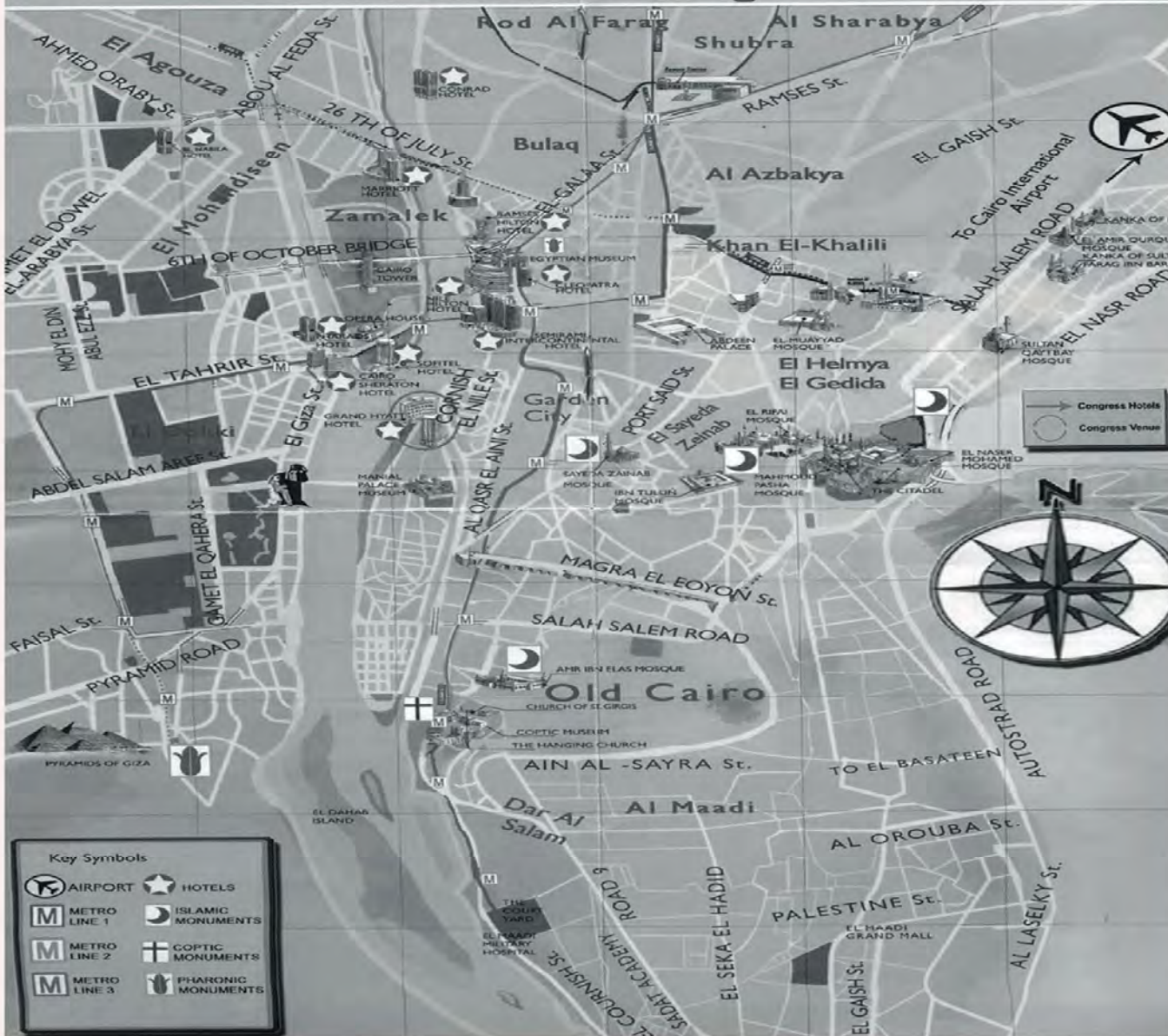
This impressive Mamluk monument served as both a mosque and as a madrassa (school). Its

minaret is one of the tallest in Cairo, it was finished in 1563. The Sultan's tomb is in the mosque and can be viewed.

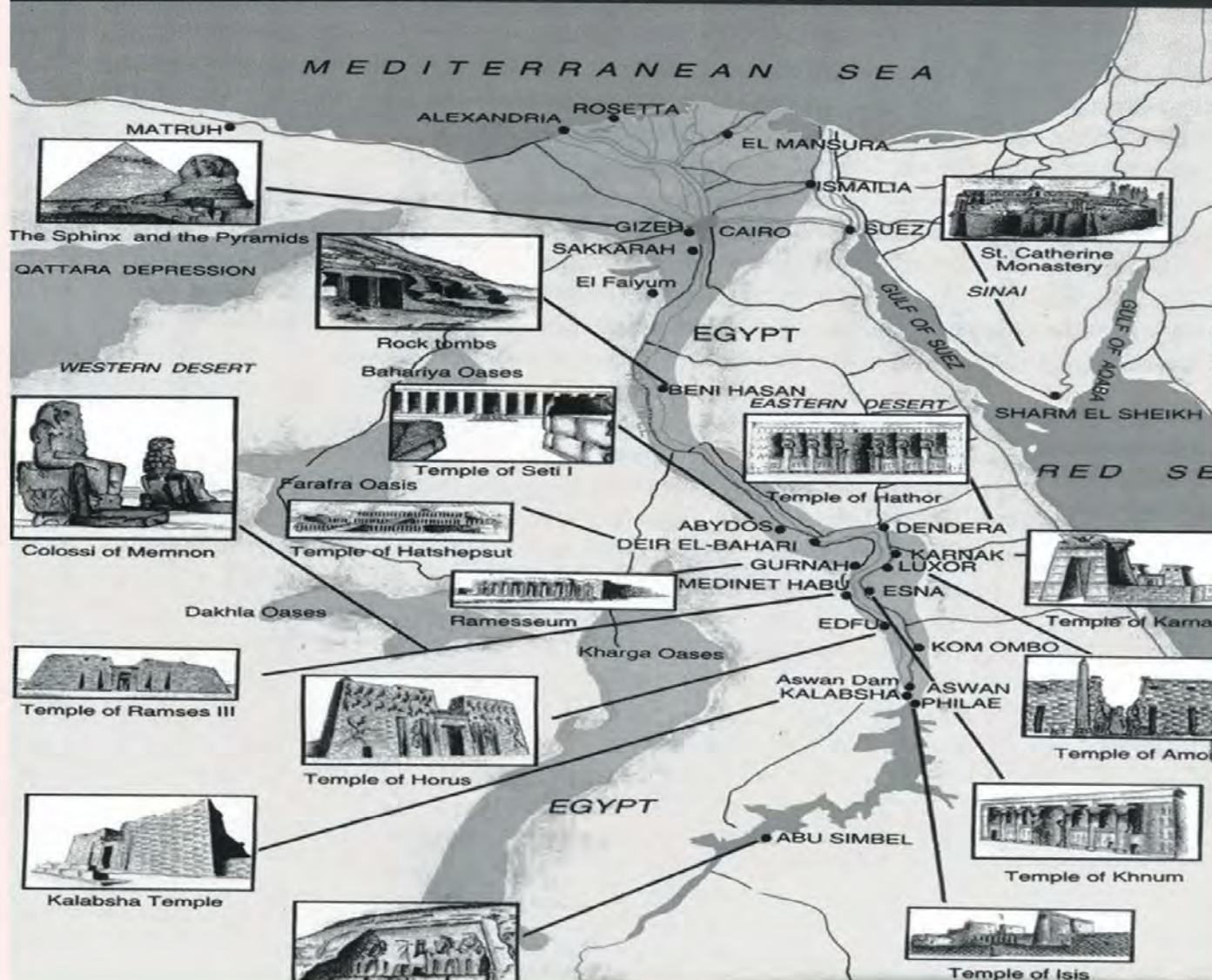




# CAIRO MAP
